What do you get when you combine a riding lawn mower, an iPhone, and my wife?

Somewhere between mowing rows, the phone slipped off the mower and found itself directly in the path of the blades. The result was nothing short of catastrophic. We carefully collected what was left of the phone and safely handled the damaged battery to eliminate any fire risk before disposing of it.

At first, I wasn't overly concerned. Replacing an iPhone is expensive, but inconvenient, not catastrophic. I assumed everything was backed up to the cloud.

Then reality hit.

The phone hadn't been backed up in more than four years.

Suddenly, this wasn't about replacing a device. It was about potentially losing four years of family photos, videos, business contacts, text conversations, notes, reminders, and countless memories that simply couldn't be recreated.

I went back to the remains of the phone hoping there was something—anything—that had survived. To my surprise, the processor and a small portion of the surrounding board appeared to be intact.
